11 mile ride The ride takes place over beautiful heath and through woodland south of Guildford. The going is mainly on sandy paths and bridleways with occasional stony tracks.

There are 2 starting points (see venue map)

- The cricket ground, Albury Heath GU5 9DB
- Roman Temple, Farley Heath GU5 9EW

There is no entry fee but there is a minimum sponsorship of £40 per rider to include £3 to cover the cost of medical attendance on the day.

3 mile ride This is for riders and horses of any age and experience but must be led or accompanied by a responsible person ON FOOT ONLY. The ride takes about 1 to 1¼hrs to complete.

The ride follows mainly sandy paths. However, some parts of the route can be muddy, so those people who are accompanying riders on foot are recommended to wear wellington boots or similar footwear.

Well behaved dogs are permitted on leads only.

There is no entry fee but there is a minimum sponsorship of £30 per rider to include £3 to cover the cost of medical attendance on the day.



Safety BHS Approved hats must be worn by all riders. Children aged 14 and under on the 11 mile ride MUST be accompanied by an adult rider. All riders ride at their own risk. We strongly recommend that all riders have valid third party insurance cover. A vet will be on call.

Horse passports must be brought to the Event Secretary on the day of the event. Horses must have been vaccinated within the last 12 months but not within 7 days of the event

Please remember that this is a pleasure ride and to respect other riders and users of the heath

Minimum sponsorship per rider is £40 for the 11 mile ride and £30 for the 3 mile ride, which includes £3 to cover the cost of medical attendance on the day.
